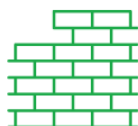

Large manufacturing warehouses often contract out sandblasters to upkeep their floors, walls, ceilings, or other surface. Huge projects like these can be very lucrative.





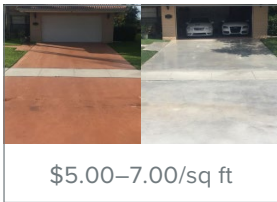

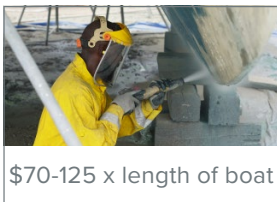

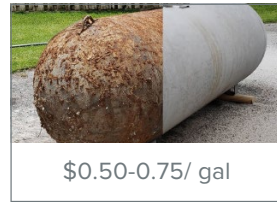
